

Corporate Member of the Year 2024

This document lists the questions and word counts to assist you in preparing the submission prior to completing it online. You will also be required to upload company logos, photos and / or documents. You may start the online nomination at any time and will be able to update or amend it prior to the closing date of Friday 22 March 2024.

Note: nominations must be completed and submitted via the online Awards platform – submissions will not be accepted via any other method. To nominate for any of our Supplier Diversity Award categories, please go to www.awards.supplynation.org.au

Note: if the business has won this award within the past two years (2022 or 2023), you are NOT eligible to be nominated for this award in 2024.

Category Description and Criteria

This award recognises a corporate member that has demonstrated exceptional commitment and leadership and driven significant growth in supplier diversity.

The winner will have:

- Developed a strong procurement program with Supply Nation Indigenous businesses.
- Demonstrated supplier diversity growth over the 2022 2023 calendar years.
- Demonstrated growth in procurement spend with Supply Nation Indigenous businesses over the 2022 2023 calendar years (will be verified against SpendTracker).
- Engaged in supplier diversity leadership and advocacy.
- Shown leadership in supplier development and capacity building.
- Demonstrated commitment to building a prosperous, vibrant and sustainable Indigenous business sector.

Context Questions

Please note: These questions are not scored by our judging panel but do provide them with valuable context about the business.

- 1. Tell us about the business you are nominating. 150 words max.
- 2. How long has the business been a member of Supply Nation?
- Tell us about the business's journey and how this has affected its vision and inspiration to work with First Nations businesses. 150 words max.

Criteria Questions

Please note: These questions are scored by our judging panel and have been developed to align with the category criteria as set out on the first page.

- Describe how the business's current procurement processes and policies support increased supplier diversity. 150 words max.
- Describe the challenges the business has faced in implementing supplier diversity and how you have mitigated / overcome these issues. 150 words max.
- 3. How many Supply Nation Indigenous businesses did you do business with in 2023? (Use numerical values only)
- 4. How many Supply Nation Indigenous businesses did the Nominee collaborate and do business with in 2022? (Use numerical values only)
- 5. What is the percentage increase in the number of Supply Nation Indigenous businesses with which the company you are nominating collaborated and did business in 2022-2023?
- 6. What was the value of contracts the business had with Supply Nation Indigenous businesses in the 2023 calendar year?
- 7. What is the value of contracts the business had with Supply Nation Indigenous businesses in the 2022 calendar year?
- 8. What is the percentage increase in the value of the business's contracts with Supply Nation Indigenous businesses over the 2022-2023 calendar years?
- 9. What percentage of the business's overall procurement spend was with Supply Nation Indigenous businesses in 2023?
- 10. What were the main factors that influenced any change in spend with Supply Nation Indigenous businesses from 2022 to 2023? **150 words max.**
- Give specific examples of the business's commitment and leadership within supplier diversity. 300 words max.
- 12. How is the business developing Supply Nation Indigenous businesses as suppliers? 150 words max.

- 13. Explain how the business is helping to build capacity with the suppliers it engages. 150 words max.
- Explain other ways the business demonstrates its commitment to the Indigenous business sector. 300 words max.
- 15. (Optional) Does the business have public targets for Indigenous procurement spend? If yes, include progress to date and provide details in any of the business's published documents, does it detail its Indigenous procurement target, and did it achieve it? **150 words max.**

Prepare to Upload Attachments

Please note: As part of this nomination, you must attach the files below when you make the nomination. The maximum size allowed is 5MB per file. The images and information you choose to upload will be used if you are selected as a finalist in the award category.

- 1. Between one and four photos of the business or team. (High-resolution, at least 1MB and portrait orientation NOT landscape.)
- 2. A high-resolution logo of the business. Vector (.ai or .eps), .png or .jpg file type please upload both colour AND black / white versions, AND horizontal and vertical / stacked options if possible.)
