## Supplier Diversity Advocate of the Year 2026

This document lists the questions and word limits to assist you in preparing the submission prior to completing it online. You will also be required to upload company logos, photos and / or documents. You may start the online nomination at any time and update or amend it prior to **11:59pm AEDT, Sunday 22 March 2026.**

**Submissions will not be accepted via any other method.**

Note: if an individual or organisation won an award in 2024 or 2025, they are **not** eligible to be nominated for the same category in 2026.

### Category Description and Criteria

This award recognises an individual from a Supply Nation member business or Indigenous supplier (including sole traders) who has driven supplier diversity growth and development within their business and/ or the Indigenous business sector.

#### **The winner will have:**

- Led their business and / or the wider sector as a champion of supplier diversity, working to develop and strengthen networks both internally and externally.
- Demonstrated outcomes in supplier diversity over the last two calendar years (2024 – 2025).
- Influenced, developed and / or implemented procurement guidelines and / or strategies to ensure that supplier diversity programs are sustainably embedded within their own and / or other businesses.
- Demonstrated commitment to building a prosperous, vibrant and sustainable Indigenous business sector.
- Proactively initiated, led, or contributed to supplier diversity outcomes that were not mandated as part of their standard position description or performance objectives.

## Context Questions

Please note: these questions are not scored by our judging panel but do provide them with valuable context about the nominee.

1. Nominee's role. (Include the nominee's role and the name of the department this role sits within) **35 words max**
2. Briefly describe what the nominee's business does. **100 words max.**
3. Nominee's biography. (Outline their professional career highlights) **30 words max.**
4. How long has the nominee been in their current role? (Include the number of years and months)
5. (Optional) Briefly describe any past relevant positions which demonstrate the nominee's commitment to supplier diversity. **150 words max.**

## Criteria Questions

Please note: these questions are scored by our judging panel and have been developed to align with the category criteria as set out on the first page.

1. Describe the initiatives the nominee has led or advocated for to promote supplier diversity within their role and / or the broader sector. **200 words max.**
2. Give examples of supplier diversity advocacy above and beyond the nominee's core role. **200 words max.**
3. How have the nominee's actions increased opportunities for Supply Nation Indigenous suppliers to win work? (Provide metrics if available) **200 words max.**
4. What are the three most important actions the nominee has taken over the 2024 – 2025 calendar years that have positively impacted the supplier diversity sector, and what were their outcomes? **250 words max.**
5. What sustainable approaches has the nominee implemented in their supply chain to drive supplier diversity and ensure long-term impact? **200 words max.**
6. Provide examples of challenges the nominee faced in implementing supplier diversity initiatives, and how they have overcome them. **150 words max.**
7. What specific strategies has the nominee implemented to increase procurement spend with Supply Nation Indigenous suppliers in 2024 and 2025? **150 words max.**
8. Provide an example of a supplier diversity initiative or outcome that the nominee personally initiated, led, or significantly influenced beyond their normal role requirements. What gap or opportunity did the nominee identify, what actions did they take, and what measurable outcomes resulted? **300 words max.**

## Upload Attachments

As part of this nomination, you must attach the files listed below. The maximum size is 5MB per file. The content you choose to upload will be used if the nominee is selected as a finalist.

1. Between one and four photos of the nominee and / or their team (high-resolution, at least 1MB and portrait orientation NOT landscape).
2. High-resolution logo of the nominee's business:
  - Full colour **and** black and white versions
  - Horizontal and vertical / stacked options
  - Preferred file type: vector (.ai or .eps), also accepted: .png, .jpg
